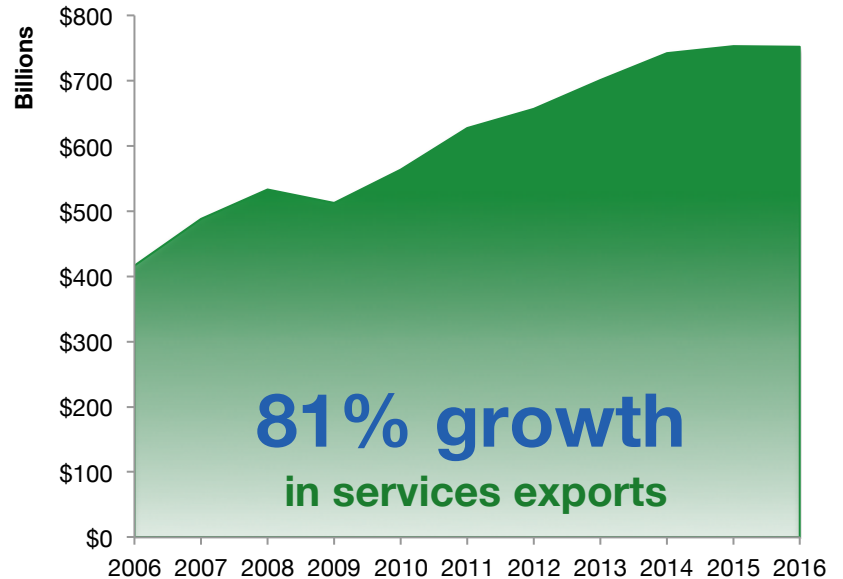
U.S Services Exports

The United States has seen a rise in overall services exports since 2006, boosting economic growth and jobs, leading to the U.S. services trade surplus of \$248 billion in 2016.

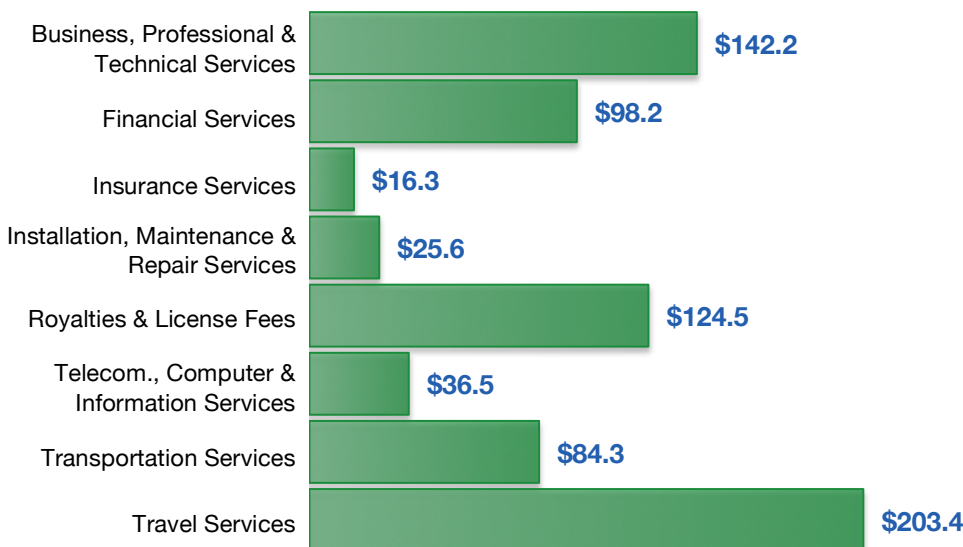
