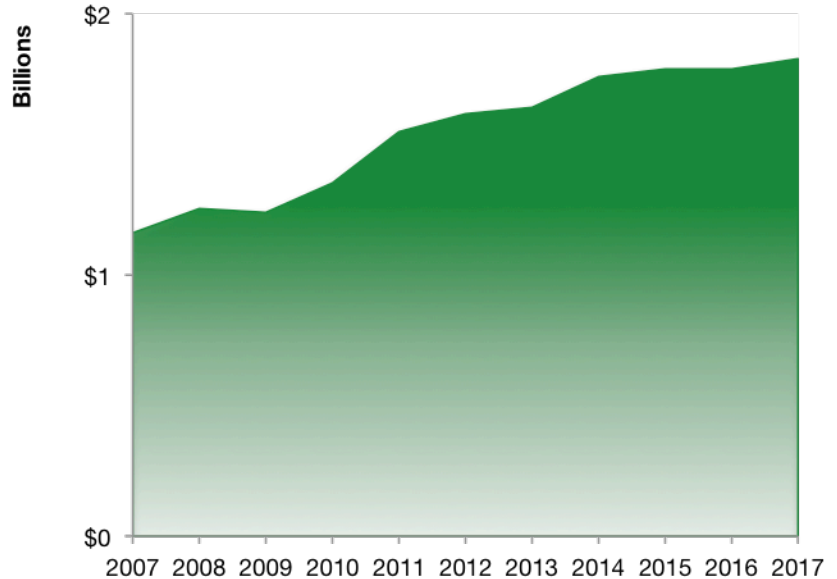
Arkansas Services Exports

U.S. Services Supply the World

Arkansas has seen a rise in overall services exports since 2007, boosting state economic growth and jobs, and contributing to the overall U.S. services trade surplus of \$248 billion in 2017.

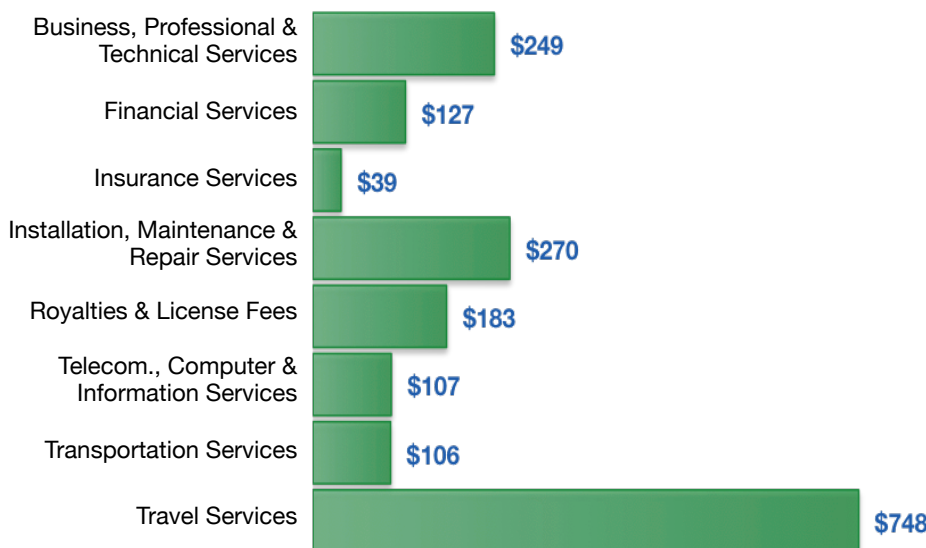

Arkansas Services Exports to Select Countries, 2017

- To China:** \$151 million in services exports supporting 1,210 jobs
- To Canada:** \$177 million in services exports supporting 1,280 jobs
- To Mexico:** \$98 million in services exports supporting 850 jobs
- To Korea:** \$63 million in services exports supporting 490 jobs
- To Japan:** \$99 million in services exports supporting 750 jobs
- To EU:** \$345 million in services exports supporting 2,490 jobs
- To UK:** \$147 million in services exports supporting 1,090 jobs

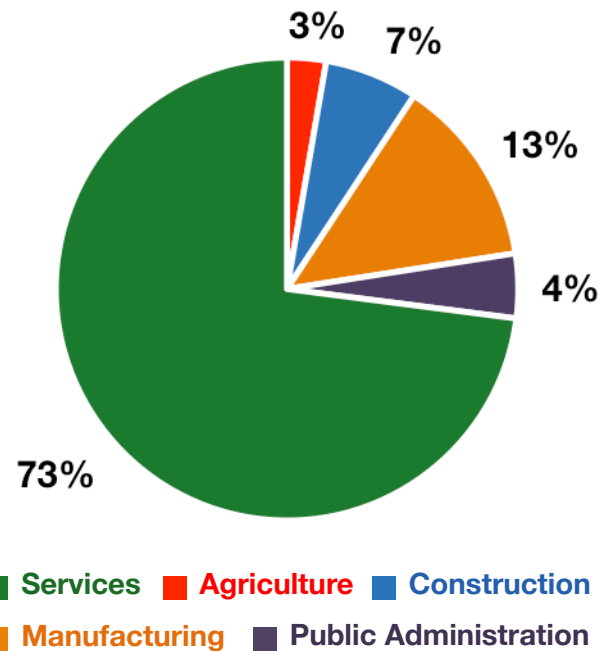

Services Fuel U.S. Jobs and Growth

Services fuel America's economic growth and jobs, generating more than 77 percent of employment in the United States and 67 percent of GDP. Services are a major component of the manufacturing and agricultural sectors, and they boost the competitiveness of those sectors.

Services accounted for 73 percent of all jobs for Arkansas workers in 2017. The top services sector for employment was Education, Health Care, & Social Assistance, which alone employed 317,710 Arkansas workers.
