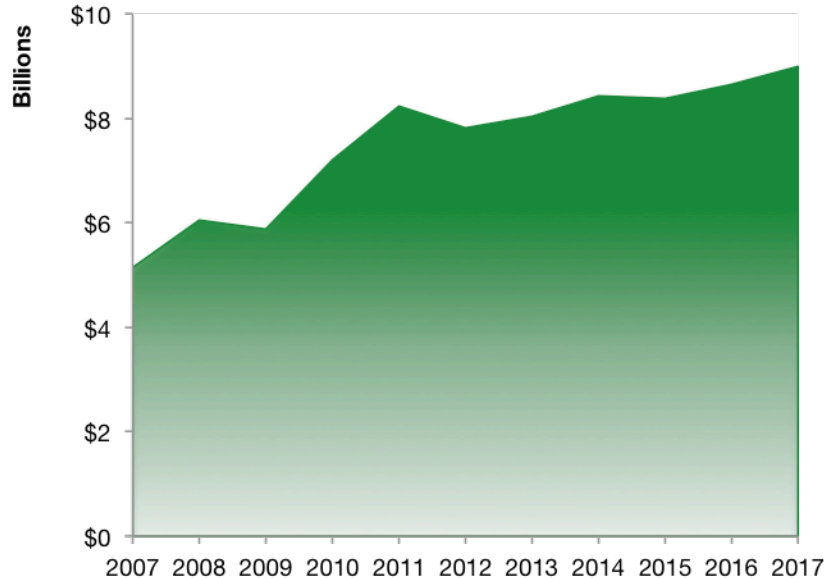
Oregon Services Exports

U.S. Services Supply the World

Oregon has seen a rise in overall services exports since 2007, boosting state economic growth and jobs, and contributing to the overall U.S. services trade surplus of \$248 billion in 2017.

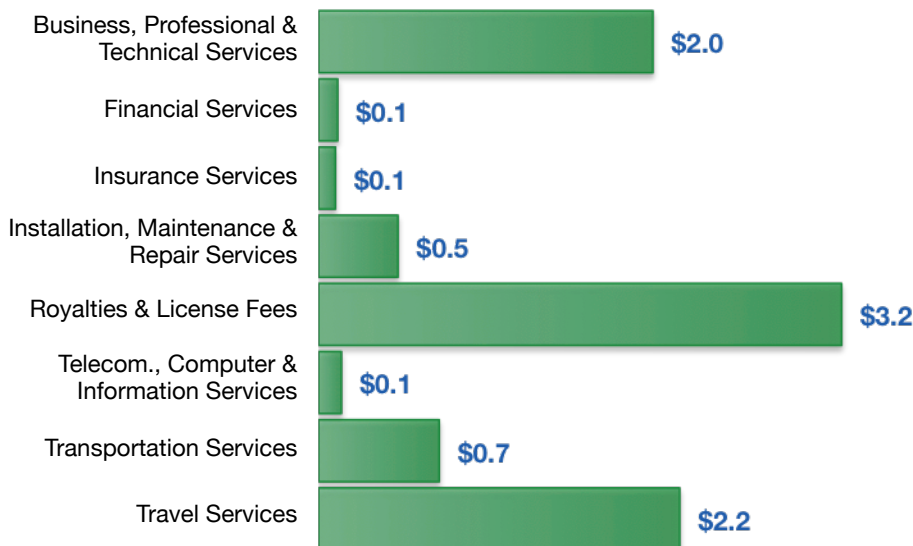

Oregon Services Exports to Select Countries, 2017

- To China:** \$646 million in services exports supporting 4,660 jobs
- To Canada:** \$577 million in services exports supporting 3,900 jobs
- To Mexico:** \$359 million in services exports supporting 2,780 jobs
- To Korea:** \$350 million in services exports supporting 2,170 jobs
- To Japan:** \$537 million in services exports supporting 3,170 jobs
- To EU:** \$2.4 billion in services exports supporting 12,910 jobs
- To UK:** \$547 million in services exports supporting 3,540 jobs

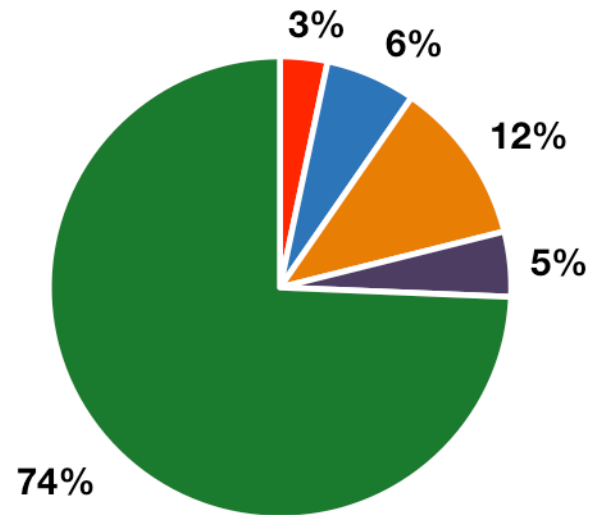

Services Fuel U.S. Jobs and Growth

Services fuel America's economic growth and jobs, generating more than 77 percent of employment in the United States and 67 percent of GDP. Services are a major component of the manufacturing and agricultural sectors, and they boost the competitiveness of those sectors.

Services accounted for 74 percent of all jobs for Oregon workers in 2017. The top services sector for employment was Education, Health Care, & Social Assistance, which alone employed 456,810 Oregon workers.
