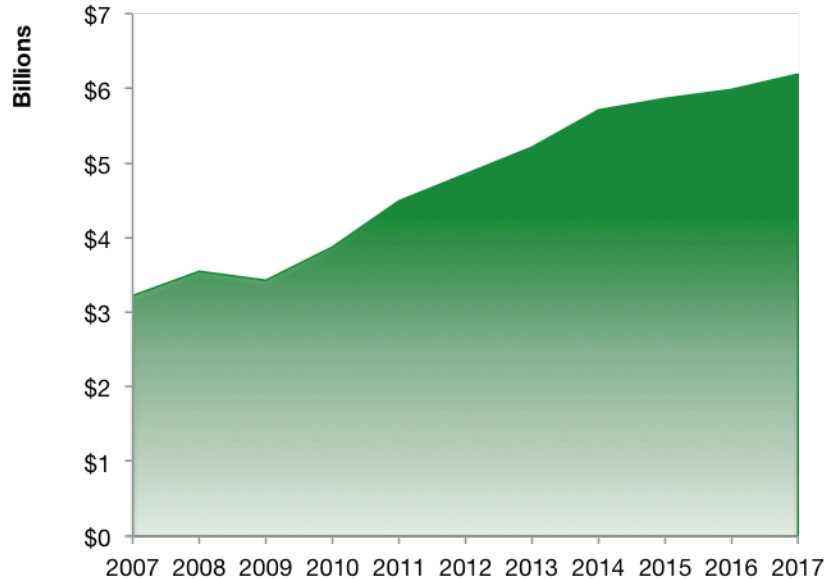
South Carolina Services Exports

U.S. Services Supply the World

South Carolina has seen a rise in overall services exports since 2007, boosting state economic growth and jobs, and contributing to the overall U.S. services trade surplus of \$248 billion in 2017.

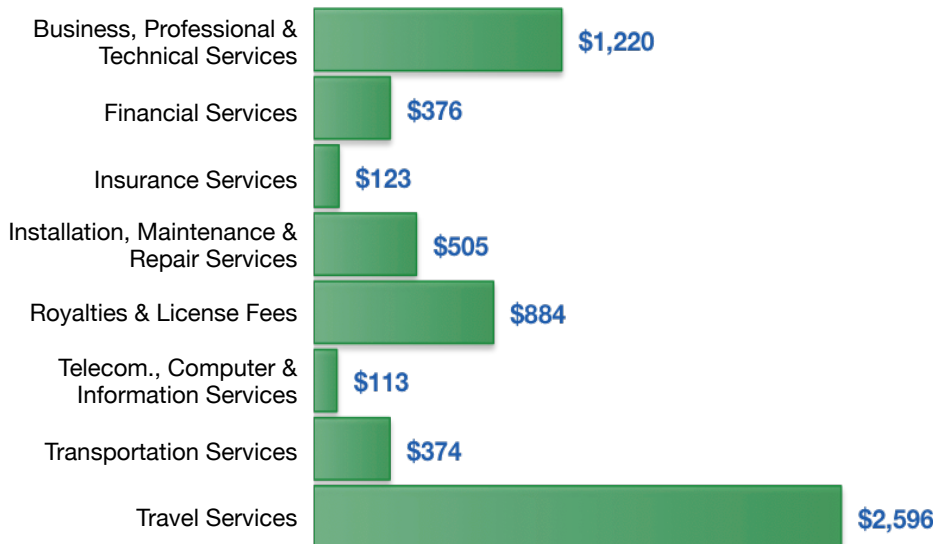

South Carolina Services Exports to Select Countries, 2017

- To China:** \$500 million in services exports supporting 4,110 jobs
- To Canada:** \$495 million in services exports supporting 3,890 jobs

- To Korea:** \$232 million in services exports supporting 1,780 jobs
- To Japan:** \$358 million in services exports supporting 2,690 jobs
- To EU:** \$1.3 billion in services exports supporting 9,370 jobs

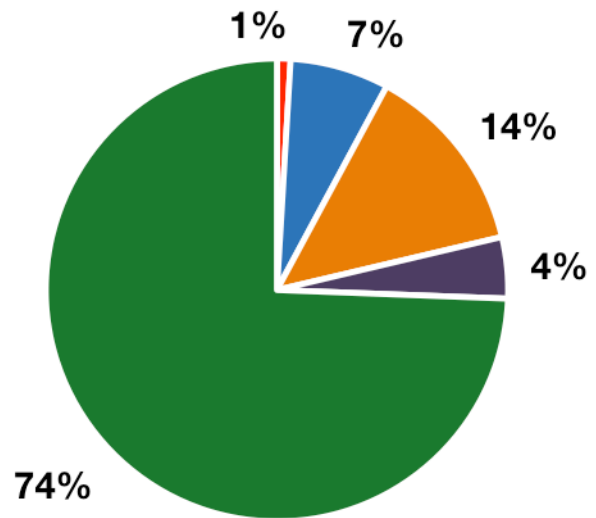

Services Fuel U.S. Jobs and Growth

Services fuel America's economic growth and jobs, generating more than 77 percent of employment in the United States and 67 percent of GDP. Services are a major component of the manufacturing and agricultural sectors, and they boost the competitiveness of those sectors.

Services accounted for 74 percent of all jobs for South Carolina workers in 2017. The top services sector for employment was Education, Health Care, & Social Assistance, which alone employed 493,500 South Carolina workers.
