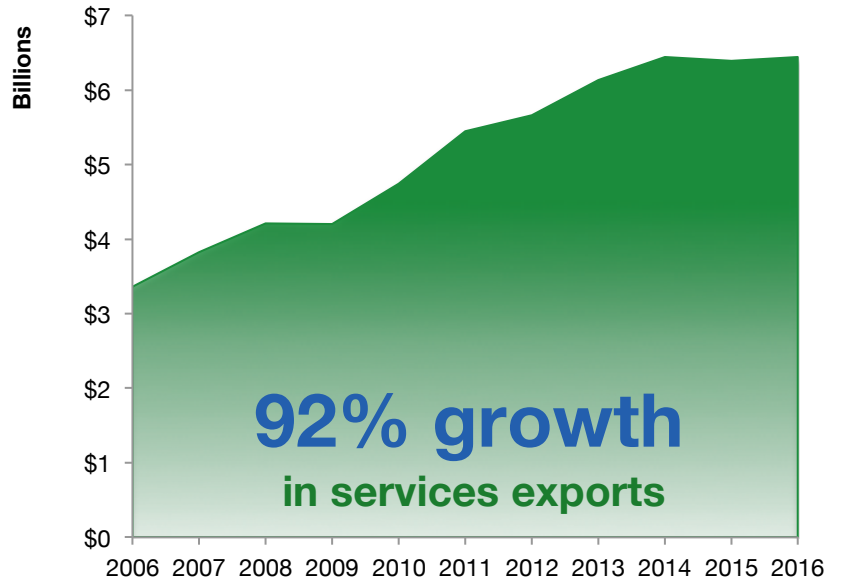
### Wisconsin Services Exports

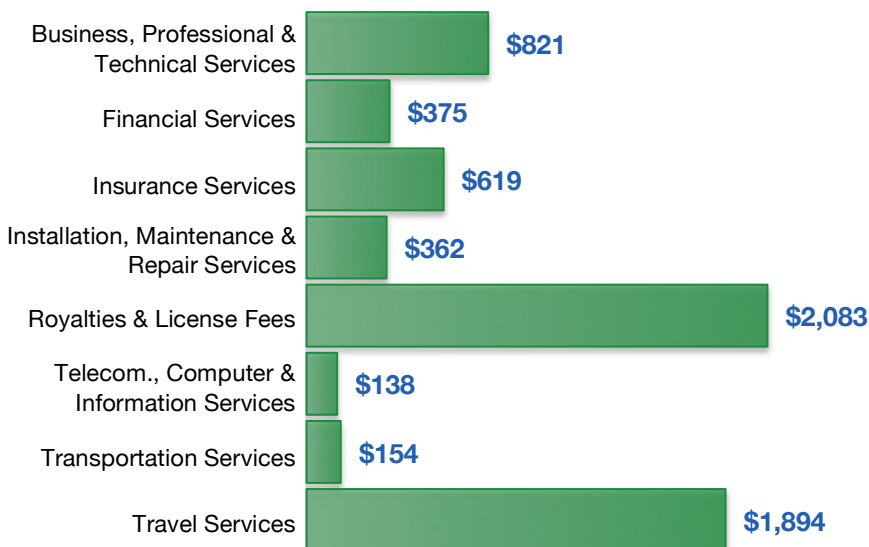
